



Chile 2010

Borders Exploration Group (BEG) is looking for leaders and venturers to travel to Chile for its 9th international expedition.

Come along to **Lindean Hall on Thursday 26th March at 7.30pm** for a presentation evening.

The adventure will take place in July 2010 for about 3 weeks with a group of venturers between 16-25 years old. They will be accompanied by about 10 volunteering leaders.

There will be a community aspect which might involve working in an orphanage, building houses in rural areas or repairing health clinics. Other activities may include hiking in the Andes Mountains, biking along the Carretera Austral or white water rafting in the Futaleufu River.



Chile is the world's longest country, with a huge varied climate ranging from the world's driest desert, the Atacama in the north, to the snow-capped Alpine climate in the south, complete with glaciers, fjords and lakes.
